### DESCRIPTION OF THE TESTS

#### EXTINGUISHER Test BY NON-PROFESSIONAL PAIRS

Outdoor fire in vehicle. The fire must be extinguished with two ABC 9 Kg powder extinguishers in the shortest time possible. The skill and organization of the two participants will be evaluated during the extinguishing.

The extinguishing will be considered complete when the last of the participants deposits the extinguisher at the starting point.

#### NON-PROFESSIONAL HOSE test

Outdoor hydrocarbons fire in square raft at ground level with columns inside and drums in the back. Extinguishing should be performed with hose lines in the shortest time possible.

Each team must assemble the hose line as they see fit, implementing their strategy and organization, using the material designated by the organization.

The extinguishing will be considered completed when the water outlet is cut off, closing the stream, and the last participant has returned to the starting point.

#### PROFESSIONAL HOSES test

Refinery fire (three-level structure outdoors) with LPG leakage on each level and a spill of flammable liquid on the lower part.

Each team must assemble the hose line as they see fit, implementing their strategy and organization, using the material designated by the organization.

The extinguishing shall be considered complete when the water outlet is cut off, closing the stream, and the last participant has returned to the starting point.
